What difference can you make?

MacIntyre receives funding to provide its core services, meaning that fundraised income can be used to buy the extras that make a real and tangible difference to the people we support.

Examples of this include: sports and play equipment, activity sessions and breaks, sensory items, equipment and technology to aid communication or music equipment.



In Milton Keynes, MacIntyre provide services and support more than 170 people with a learning disability and other complex needs. People with a learning disability and other complex needs often find it difficult to participate in sport due to low confidence, inaccessibility, lack of support and lack of opportunity.
